Simple Search Box

On the Platform homepage (www.rsc.org/platform), you will find a **Simple Search** box. Begin by typing into this box and its auto complete function will suggest relevant search terms that might be of interest.

This box searches through content hosted on the RSC Publishing Platform (journals and eBooks) and content on the RSC Publishing website (databases).

To use this search box, type into the **Full Text** box:

- Keyword
- Author name
- Article/chapter title
- Reference
- Digital Object Identifier (DOI).

Press **Search** and it will automatically generate relevant results in the **Search Results** screen.

Alternatively, click on the drop down to specify which type for more defined searching:

- Full Text
- Title
- Author
- o DOI
- ISBN.

Search Results

The **Search Results** screen displays relevant results in four tabs and the number of results found:

1. All

- 2. Journal Articles
- 3. Book Chapters
- 4. Non-RSC Articles results from RSC A&I databases available through subscription.

What Can I Do?

- **Download Citation** for referencing from each result
- Expand/Collapse related images to result ·
- Download the **PDF** or **Rich HTML** (type available dependent on subscription)
- Click on the article link to review the abstract and supplementary information
- Sort By relevance to search, latest or oldest
- Modify Search takes you to the Advanced Search
- Save this Search saves in My Profile
- Search History displays your recent searches.

Article Landing Page

The article landing page contains three tabs:

- 1. Abstract article abstract
- 2. Cited by who the article is cited by (RSC currently sources this data from CrossRef)
- Compounds this is where an article has had its chemical terms and compounds indexed and will use *ChemSpider* to search for the relevant structure and display. (*It may not always appear*).
